
OFFICIAL





This Code of Conduct aims to give everyone a guide to what is expected of us as part of Dumfries Junior Curling. Please read the following, sign and return to the Committee.

- I will encourage my child to Curl in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will consider the wellbeing of Curlers on and off the ice at all times.
- I will inform my child's coach of any injury or illness that may impact on their performance and/or the safety and wellbeing of others.
- I will always promote the positive aspects of the sport and taking part and will encourage my child to value their performance and not just their results.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all Curlers, coaches and officials at every practice session, competition and test session.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the results of a competitive event.
- I will ensure my child is ready and prepared for lessons on time and is appropriately dressed. At competitions, I will ensure my child is ready, prepared and dressed at an appropriate time as indicated by the coaching staff and/or Team Managers.
- I will not approach coaching staff during lessons and will use the appropriate method of contact for any queries to relevant committee members/coaches.
- I will always show respect for my child's coach.
- I agree to always follow guidelines and regulations laid down by the Club and the governing body.

- Child Protection Policies are in force to protect your children. Changing facilities are in place for both male and female Curlers and gender rules must be followed by children and parents/carers. Parents/Carers must not enter the changing rooms unless they have current PVG clearance, processed by the Club.
- I will not take photographs or video during club sessions without permission from the Head Coach.
- I will not post video or pictures taken during club sessions on the internet or social media without permission from the Head Coach.
- I will ask my child to treat other Curlers, coaches, visitors, parents, staff and officials with respect, regardless of race, colour, sexual orientation or ability. I will do the same.
- I will show appreciation and recognize the importance of volunteers and club officials.
- I will display high standards of conduct at all times, both at Dumfries Ice Bowl and when travelling for competitions. I will not demonstrate behaviour that could bring the Club into disrepute.
- I will not be aggressive or abusive to coaches, staff, parents, volunteers, visitors, children or other users at Dumfries Ice Bowl or while travelling and representing the Club.
- I will be a positive role model for my child and other Curlers.
- I will encourage my child to display high standards of conduct at all times, both at Dumfries Ice Bowl and when travelling for competitions. I shall ensure they read and understand the Curlers' Code of Conduct.
- I will teach my child to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will support all the opponents in my child's competition and respect the rights of all Curlers to participate.
- I will respect the decisions of officials and their authority during competitions and test sessions and teach my child to do likewise.
